- 1. NWNW and Commissioners-Continue to monitor % of water loss; currently at +15%. Why the drop from +30% to +15%?
- 2. New asphalt on Hubble Court is still on the schedule; Nathan says it should be in July
- 3. Information regarding the STORZ quick connectors for fire hydrants: Nathan and crew will inventory our existing fire hydrants and we will get an estimate. They will be 4 x 4 or 4 x 5. Has that information been compiled yet?
- 4. We discussed the issue of water quality at Cottage Glen and Nathan was planning to do a site visit to look into whether there is a water aging problem and the reservoir is not turning over frequently enough. Did that occur? What happened?
- 5. Nik did a well-depth measurement which was on the April bill. What were the results?
- 6. Was there any water testing conducted at all in the last month? We haven't received anything from the lab. What is the next testing that will be conducted on our water quality?
- 7. Water Shortage response plan; Jill will handle this.
- 8. Research on self reading water meters. Dave will arrange for a representative (Charlie Sovacool) from Consolidated Supply Company to attend our next meeting to discuss. NWNW will prepare an estimate on changing out the meters. We would like to get meters that are automatically read (radio? bluetooth?) and that eliminate the human source of error.
- 9. Status of the lead and copper project, to be done by NWNW
- 10. The ERP needs to be updated with contact information from NWNW. Does anything else need to be changed? Jill and Jaci will look it over.
